a solution. When facing a problem, the children will take the cards off the wall and chose which one they will use to solve their conflict. Kindergarten teachers say that the area most children need more practice in before entering kindergarten is in the area of social/emotional development. Each child needs to be able to meet their own needs and solve their problems on their own so that the teacher can focus on the material being presented. Some ways we are working on this in daycare are by using

Solution cards, using words to express their feelings, and learning ways to calm down (count to 10, take a deep breath, sing a song, walk away, etc.) **Thank you!**
